CHAPTER 9 Part 3 – Verses 31-43

Rest in the Midst of Persecution (vs. 31)

- God can give you peace in the midst of the storms
 - Rest: eirēnē: State of national tranquility; peace between individuals; security, safety, prosperity, felicity, (because peace and harmony make and keep things safe and prosperous) Thayer's Greek Definitions
- Note the components to the rest of these churches
 - Not an isolated condition (all Judea, Galilee and Samaria)
 - They were edified built up Eph. 4:16, 29
 - They walked in the fear of the Lord Psalm 111:10; Psalm 34:7-9
 - They walked in the comfort of the Holy Ghost John 6:63
 - They were growing and at rest while growing 2 Pet. 3:18; Acts 2:47

The Power of God Operating Through Peter

Aeneas Is Healed

- Peter emphasizes the name of Jesus who is the Healer
- Note that Aeneas is told to make his bed and not carry it since he is already at home.

→When God is not always calling us away from home but to make home better.

Dorcas Restored to Life

- Called "a certain disciple" implying she stood out
- She was full of good works and almsdeeds (charitable) and SHE DID THEM
 - Some are full of themselves, full of good thoughts, etc. but she carried them out to help others
- Even those that love the Lord and do good face sickness and death vs. 37
- They made plans in faith
 - Washed her body but also went to get Peter (usually with hot water)
 - > When they heard Peter was not too far away, they sent for him
 - > Vs. 39: Peter encounters an atmosphere of deep grief
 - Widows weeping holding the proofs of her ministry to them
 - What does the scripture tell us is available when our hearts are heavy? Isa. 61:3
 - > Vs. 40: Peter has to shift the atmosphere
 - Puts them all out when things are difficult or you lack direction, you may need to thin the crowd so you can hear from the Lord Mat. 26:36-46; Luke 5:15-16; Mat. 6:6; Mar. 5:39-43
 WHO ARE YOU GIVING ACCESS TO THAT IS PREVENTING YOU FROM BREAKTHROUGH?
 - He prays then speaks to the dead woman
 - His speaking by faith brought back vision as a sign she was alive
 - Vs. 41: We must not only speak but also reach
 - Vs. 41: We have a responsibility to build up the Body when Jesus manifests His Power through us – Mat. 10:5-8
 - Vs. 42-43: The fruit of Dorca's resuscitation: many come to faith John 11:45

The Book of Acts Study Notes CHAPTER 10 Part 1

The Vision of Cornelius

- Caesarea was the headquarters of Roman governor of Judea
- Cornelius: Roman centurion of the Italian band (regiment)
 - They were considered most loyal of Roman troops
 - Loyal to Roman government but also devout and feared God
 - Devout: eusebes: pious and dutiful; (same used of Ananias in Acts 22:12)
 - Respected by the Jews Acts 10:22
 - Feared God with all his house instructed his family to reverence God
 - Gave much alms to the people charitable deeds James 1:27; Psa. 41:1
 - Prayed to God always communicated with God Luke 18:1; Psa. 119:2; Pro. 2:2-5
- Vs. 3: His vision was not the result of spiritual laziness but of spending time in prayer and fasting Acts 10:30
 - > At the 9th hour which was a customary hour of prayer for Jews (3pm)
 - He saw clearly in the vision
- Vs. 4: Prayers and Alms as a memorial
 - Memorial: though he was not Jewish and did not offer sacrifices accordingly, God was pleased with his prayers and alms – compare Isa. 1:11-15 with 1 Sam. 15:22 and Rom. 12:1
- Vs. 5-8: The Instructions and The Obedience
 - Send for Peter
 - Your answer is with Peter

➔ Often, our answers from God are connected to our obedience and interaction with others. Who has God sent to help you that you didn't want to hear from?

Ask Naaman in 2 Kings 5
