

Part 1: Being Rooted Matters

- Growing in Christ calls for more than surface Christianity
 - What is surface Christianity?
 - Outward appearance but lacking depth
 - Incomplete understanding of faith in Christ
 - Unwillingness to listen Heb. 5:11-14 (Read vs. 11 in MSG), 2 Tim. 4:3
 - May be more familiar with traditions, phrases and sayings than knowing Christ Mark 7:7-13
 - Faith that is easily blown away by obstacles, trials and everyday life experiences Mat. 13:6
- Being rooted (firm foundation) is very important John 15:1-8
- We must be careful what kind of foundation we are laying for others as they come to Christ
 - Are we rooting them in Christ or something else? Col. 2:6-7
- Likewise, we are responsible for what we take root in
 - Are we taking root with the ungodly? Psa. 1:1
 - > Are we rooted in love? Eph. 3:16-19
 - Are we rooted in the Word of God? Deut. 6:6-7; James 1:22
- ❖ God will uproot you from ungodliness in order for you to take root in Christ Col. 1:21-23
- ❖ We must be willing to go deeper in Christ Heb. 6:1-3
 - Questions from Psalm 1:1-3
 - What does it mean to meditate day and night? Psa. 119:11-15; Psa. 77:12, 1 Tim. 4:14-16
 - What does the positioning of the tree in vs. 3 tell us about how we should be positioned?
 - What are some streams we feed from?
 - What are 3 expectations of the tree planted by the rivers of water in vs. 3?

Part 2: Transformation is the Goal - Renewing Your Mind is the Key

Key Passage: Romans 12:1-2

The Goal of Transformation

- How would you define transformation?
 - ➤ A thorough or dramatic change in form or appearance; a metamorphosis during the life cycle of an animal; in physics, the induced or spontaneous change of one element into another by a nuclear process Oxford Languages Dictionary
- ❖ Our ultimate goal as Christians is to be transformed into the image of Christ − 2 Cor. 3:18, Rom. 8:29
 - To be more Christ-like Phil. 2:5-8; 1 Cor. 11:1
 - To have deep roots in Christ Eph. 3:17-18
- ❖ We all have work to do towards meeting the goal Eph. 4:20
- ❖ I've got to take off the old man so I can put on the new man Eph. 4:22-24

Conformity Is Not Always Your Friend

- Romans 12:1 lays out that the way to transformation is through mind-renewal
- We are cautioned about conforming to:
 - ➤ Old passions 1 Pet. 1:14
 - ➤ The wrong circles Psa. 1
 - > Every that says it's spiritual 1 John 4:1
 - > The world Rom. 12:2; James 4:4

Renewing My Mind

- Romans 12:1 lays out that the way to transformation is through mind-renewal
- The importance of the mind
- To renew my mind, I've got to deal with my thoughts, beliefs, and actions
- How do I renew my mind?
 - It is the work of the Word, the Holy Spirit and your will
 - ➤ I must submit to God's standard Rom. 12:2
 - > I must take responsibility for where I allow my thoughts to linger Phil. 4:8
 - I must arrest them 2 Cor. 10:3-5

Questions to ponder:

- What does conforming to the world look like?
- What can happen when you linger on ungodly thoughts?
- Likewise, what happens when you think on what God told you to? Phil. 4:8
- Identify a negative thought or mindset you are dealing with and find Biblical truth to replace it with.



Part 3: Fruitfulness - The Evidence of Growth

Key Passage: Galatians 5:22-23

The Connection Matters

- Just as Jesus tells us in John 15:1-8 about abiding, what you connect to will determine what type of fruit you bear – John 15:1-8
- ❖ We are warned in scripture about our connections Psalm 1; Eph. 5:11; Rom. 16:17-18
- ❖ We produce what we are Gen. 1:11, 26; John 8:44
- Learn to watch what is in your garden Song of Solomon 2:15

The Evidence Matters

- ❖ We are not known by our aspirations but by our fruit Mat. 7:16-23; Mat. 12:33-45
- ❖ Production is a result of process and not pretense Heb. 12:11-16; 2 Tim. 2:21

The Fruit we should be bearing

- ❖ Gal. 5:22-23
- There is more than Gal. 5:22-23
 - Goodness, righteousness, truth Eph. 5:9
 - ➤ Obedience Phil. 2:12-18
 - Good works Mat. 5:16; Col. 1:10; Eph. 2:10
 - Evangelism Mat. 28:19; Acts 1:8
 - Repentance Mat. 3:8-10
 - Righteousness and Justice Isa. 5:1-7

Questions to ponder:

- What kind of fruit have you been producing?
- What is limiting your production of Godly fruit?



Part 4: Going Through Growing through

Key Passages: James 1; 2 Pet. 1:3-8; Phil. 1:6

There is no progress without process

- Note Paul's confidence in God completing the work He has begun in the believers in Philippi Phil. 1:6
 - Confidence in God completing what He has started, not man Isa. 55:11
 - ➤ It is God that is doing a work in the believer 1 Thes. 5:24; Heb. 13:21; Psa. 138:8
- It's important to remember that it is God who oversees the process
- ❖ What does the process look like? 2 Pet. 1:3-11
 - > Vs. 3: We have been given all we need to live godly
 - ➤ Vs. 4: The promises enable us to be partakers of the divine (god-like) nature
 - We have the opportunity to partake but have to make the choice to partake.
 - ➤ Vs. 5-8: We must be diligent about this process

God expects us to grow up

Don't skip the milk (1 Pet. 2:2) but don't get stuck on milk forever – Heb. 5:12-14

God is calling for us to persevere

- God wants us to change our perspective on the adversity James 1:1-12; Romans 5:1-5
 - Crowns aren't cheap Rev. 2:10
- ❖ Don't neglect the importance of prayer while your are persevering Eph. 6:18; Rom. 12:12
- Remember the testimonies of those before you James 5:11; Heb. 12:1-2
- God rewards perseverance Rev. 3:10

We are able to endure when we operate in love and are led by faith

4 1 Cor. 16:12-13; Heb. 12:2; Rom. 5:3-5

The growth from it

- ❖ It will work for our good Rom. 8:28; Gen. 50:20; 2 Cor. 4:17; 1 Pet. 5:7-11
- Learning to simply trust Him Psa. 46:10

The ministry from it

- The opportunity for God to show Himself mightily Judges 7:2
- From the failure and from the trial Luke 22:31-34
