What is grace?

- ❖ God's unmerited favor, not earned or deserved Eph. 2:8-9
- ❖ God's grace is understood through His divine power and provision
 - His Power: Eph. 3:7; 2 Cor. 12:9
 - ➤ His Provision: Heb. 4:16;

Question to ponder: Is favor with man more important than the grace of God?

How do grace and favor work together?

- Grace is what brings us into relationship with God while favor in many cases is the tangible evidence
 - > Favor flows because of God's grace Psalm 16:11
- God's grace is unconditional while favor can often be the result of obedience and relationship

Grace is God's Prerogative

- Grace did not originate with man but God
- ❖ God is not obligated to explain why He extends grace –
- Grace demonstrates the mercy and love of God towards us Romans 5:1-8

A lack of grace could indicate the opposition of God

James 4:6

God's Grace has made me who I am

- ❖ His grace saved me Eph. 2:4-5, 8
- His grace forgives and redeems me Eph. 1:7
- ❖ His grace frees me Rom. 6:12-14
- ❖ His grace focuses me Gal. 2:19-21
- ❖ His grace redefines me 1 Cor. 15:9-10
- His grace repurposed me Acts 20:24
- ❖ His grace sustains me 2 Cor. 12:9
- ❖ His grace sanctifies me Rom. 12:1-2
- ❖ His grace justifies me Rom. 3:24
- His grace builds me Acts 20:32

Lesson 2: Sustaining Grace

Key Scripture: 2 Corinthians 12:9

What is sustaining Grace?

- God's power that keeps us in the midst of challenges and situations and propels us forward in spite of them.
- Saving grace brings us to relationship with God while sustaining grace keeps us in relationship when things get tough

What does it mean to be sustained? Psalm 91

- Means you have been established
- Means something has or is attempting to cause me to leave where I have been established
- Means the power of the circumstances is not greater than the power of the One keeping you in the midst of it
- Means He keeps you in spite of the situation
 - ➤ Paul kept the thorn but the thorn couldn't keep Paul 2 Cor. 12:9
- Means I have His Peace in the midst of it all Phil. 4:6-7
- ❖ Means I have hope and expectation Rom. 8:18; Eph. 3:20

Question to ponder: Is it possible to have more and yet not be sustained?

Phil. 4:11-13

How do I walk in sustaining grace?

- ❖ Walk with the Sustainer Psa. 55:22; Heb. 4:16
- ❖ Walk in faith and refuse to fear Isa. 41:10
- ❖ Pray 1 Thes. 5:17
- Confess God's ability in your weakness Psa. 73:26; Isa. 40:29
- Get in The Word –
- ❖ Praise God in spite of it all 1 Thes. 5:18
- ❖ Worship God based upon your relationship and not your situation Col. 3:2
- Realize that God is growing me while He is sustaining me James 1:2-4

Key Scripture: Col. 4:6

Our Words Matter

❖ They are indicative of our hearts – Psa. 19:14; Col. 3:5-8; Mat. 15:2-11

It is often easier to speak of something you have experienced

Titus 2:11-14

It is more difficult to speak by something or someone you don't know

Rom. 5:1-2

Question to Ponder:

How can you experience His Grace and not speak by it?

God is calling us to speak by His Grace

Col. 4:2-6

Gracious speech does not exclude us from correction and rebuke

Jude 1:1-25

Key Principles to Graceful Speech

- ❖ Your speech tells us of your heart Col. 3:15-16
- ❖ Speak the truth in love Eph. 4:15; Pro. 12:22
- ❖ Your tone matters as much as your words Pro. 14:29; Pro. 15:1
- ❖ Speak for edification and not offence James. 3:2; Eph. 4:29
- Speak governed by the Holy Spirit Luke 12:11-12
- ❖ Speak by wisdom Ecc. 10:12; Pro. 10:19
- Your speech should be seasoned with salt
 - Stopping corruption instead of spreading it further 1 Pet. 3:10; Eph. 4:29
- ❖ Speak humbly Pro. 16:24
- ❖ Bless instead of cursing Rom. 12:14



Lesson 4: Applying the Lessons of Grace

Key Scripture: Col. 4:6

God expects us to get understanding and then apply it by faith - Pro. 4:7

Our faith gives us access into the grace – Rom. 5:1-2

- ❖ This lets us know that we are able to walk in the gifts God has given us by His grace
 - ➤ We are His workmanship Eph. 2:10

What does it mean to walk in grace?

- Accepting His forgiveness
 - Confessing that I am no longer condemned Rom. 6:14
 - ➤ Confessing that God can and still wants to use me 2 Tim. 1:9
 - ➤ Confessing my identity comes from Christ Rom. 3:21-22
 - ➤ Confessing His worthiness is why I am able to be forgiven 2 Cor. 5:21
 - ➤ Allow restoration to work in my life 1 John 1:9
- ❖ Extending forgiveness to others Mat. 6:14-15; Mat. 18:21-35
- ❖ Speaking by grace Col. 4:6

Question to Ponder:

Does your compassion for others come close to the compassion you want God to have for you?

- ❖ Using your grace-given gifts to serve others 1 Pet. 4:8-10; Rom. 12:6-8
 - ➤ We don't get to determine the gift and likewise don't get to determine who needs the gift Phil. 2:5-8; Acts 9:10-19
 - Not merely those you like but those who have nothing to give you in return or even hate you. Matt. 10:5-8; Isa. 55:1; John 1:16
- Recognize that grace is there for you when you need it Heb. 4:15-16, 2 Cor. 12:7-10
