The Heart of a Harvester

Key passage: Romans 10:1

- We do not pursue what we do not desire. 1 Sam. 17:29-32
- You can't fix a desire problem with religious programs or commands.
 - God gives us choices Deut. 30:11-20; Joshua 24:15
 - God has made accommodations for our choices Isa. 5:14; 2 Pet. 2:4
- What does "heart's desire" mean?
 - Desire reveals our hearts
 - Rom. 10:1: Heart's (kardia):
 - (figuratively) the thoughts or feelings (mind); also (by analogy) the middle Strong's Hebrew and Greek Definitions
 - Rom. 10:1: desire (eudokia): 1) will, choice; 2) delight, pleasure, satisfaction; 3) desire
- There is no shortage of harvest but seemingly a shortage of capacity to reap the harvest Mat. 9:37-38
 - We must ask ourselves some questions?
 - Is there a shortage of souls that need saving or a shortage of hearts willing to reach them?
 - Is my heart in alignment with God's Will? John 4:34

What can I do if I don't have the heart of a harvester?

- Remember Eph. 2:1-8
- Release to offenses Eph. 4:31-32; Luke 23:34; Acts 7:60
- Renew your mind Rom. 12:1-1-2
- Refresh by the Word of God John 15:7; James 4:7; Eph. 4:17-24

What are some "I wills" of the heart of a harvester?

- I will pray concerning the harvest Mat. 9:37-38; Acts 13:1-4; Acts 8:14; Acts 6
 - ➢ Workers, strategies, assignments, systems
- I will operate with compassion concerning the harvest Mat. 14:14
- I will not sit idly and allow the harvest to be spoiled in the field Mat. 9:37-38; John 3:16; 2 Pet. 3:9
- ♦ I will do my part in watering what God is growing in the field 1 Cor. 3:6
- I will make room to accommodate the harvest 1 Chron. 4:10
- I will reap the harvest with character and integrity Psa. 26:1
- I will receive help with the harvest Luke 10:1-3; Mark 6:7
- I will not give up until I reap of the harvest Gal. 6:9

Key passage: Matthew 9:35-11:1

Can you be trusted in the field?

Enduring while reaping the harvest

Some Keys to a Healthy Harvester

- Keeps a proper perspective on the harvest 1 Cor. 3:6-8
- Strives to balance the load while harvesting 1 Cor. 9:27
- Takes care of:
 - ➢ Your relationship with God − Phil. 4:13;
 - Yourself physically and mentally 1 Cor. 6:19-20; 1 Cor. 10:31; 1 Pet. 5:7-9
 - Let's really think about this scripture Gal. 5:14
 - ➢ Your family − 1 Tim. 5:8
- Respects and works in community Mar. 6:6-13
 - Notice that he commanded a community not just an individual Mark 6:7; Luke 9:1
 - We must ask ourselves can we really be effective at reaching the harvest of souls if we are unable to work together – Ecc. 4:12
 - Unity draws Christ to the scene Mat. 18:20; Psa. 133:1
 - Unity keeps us focused on who we are working for Col. 3:23
 - Working together brings growth to the body Eph. 4:16
- Makes sure to bring the right tools to the field
 - Catchy phrases and theatrics don't save souls Jesus saves 1 Pet. 1:18-19; Eph. 2:8-10
 - > Do you have the Power of the Holy Ghost to witness? Acts 1:8
 - Do you know the Word of God?
 - Are you still teachable? Acts 18:26
- Does not reject but cultivates the seeds the master has planted Acts 9:10-18
- Does not quit because of excuses but brings in those the master desires Luke 14:12-24
- Is attentive to what's happening around the harvest Mat. 13:24-43



It's Okay to Grow

There is a right and a wrong growth

Some questions to consider

- Do I want to grow?
- What do my actions indicate about my desire to grow?
- Am I growing?
 - > Am I being given the necessary tools to grow? Mat.
 - > Am I using what's available to me
- Am I willing to make room for growth?
 - Giving others opportunities
 - Training and preparing others
- Do I have the courage to grow?

The Prayer of Jabez

- What we know about Jabez?
 - Significance can not be fully understood outside of understanding his name
 - Jabez: ya'bêts: to grieve, sorrowful; the name resulted from the painful birth experienced by his mother (vs. 9)
 - From his birth, grief and sorrow has been spoken over him.
 - > He must have been well known since the Bible does not give his lineage or much else about him
 - He was more honorable than his brothers
 - Honorable: rich, honorable; to make weighty (either good or bad)
 - As believers, we must believe that the God can place a greater weight of glory upon us 2 Cor. 4:17
- Jabez renewed his mind

Just like Jabez, we can't change the circumstances of how we were raised. But, we can and must follow his example and renew our minds.

- Rom. 12:2: renewing anakainōsis: renovation
 - Renew in O.T.
 - châdash 1 Sa. 11:14; Psa. 51:10; Lam. 5:21: to be new, to rebuild, to repair
 - châlaph Isa. 40:31; Isa. 41:1: to hasten away, pass on, spring up, pierce or change: abolish, alter change, cut off, go on forward, grow up, be over, pass (away, on, through), renew, sprout, strike through
- Jabez took it to God in prayer
 - ➢ We should pray in successes − 1 Kings 8:26-30
 - ➢ We should pray in discouragements − 1 Sam . 30:6-8



- We should pray without fainting Luke 18:1
 - Faint ekkakeo: to be (bad or) weak, that is, (by implication) to fail (in heart): faint, be weary
- Jabez requested to be blessed "indeed"
 - We all are blessed (Mat. 5:45); However, we are not all blessed "indeed"
 "There are many who are blessed, but they are not blessed indeed. That is, they have something that is in one sense a blessings (such as family, salvation, wealth, fame, health, security), but yet because of fundamental dissatisfaction in their life, they are not blessed indeed" (David Guzik)
- > Jabez requested enlarged territory request God allow him to go beyond the limits...
 - Surrounded by Canaanites and other idol worshippers
 - Wanted to make greater impact for God Jos 17:14-18; Jdg 1:27-36; Pro 10:22; Mat. 9:37
- Jabez prayed for the Hand of God to be on him Bible talk for God's Power and Presence Joshua 4:24; Isaiah 59:1; Psa. 77:10
- > Jabez prayed for God to keep him from evil
 - Evil: ra' râ'âh: bad or (as noun) evil (naturally or morally) John 17:15
 Psa 32:3-4, Psa 51:8, Psa 51:12; Mat 26:75; Joh 21:17; 2Co 2:1-7; Eph 4:30; Rev 3:19
- GOD DID IT!

1Ki 3:7-13; Job 22:27-28; Psa 21:4, Psa 65:2, Psa 66:19-20, Psa 116:1-2; Mat 7:7-11; Eph 3:20
