- ❖ A men, our ultimate objective should be to please God
- **❖** Pleasing God entails manifesting His purpose and promise in our lives
- **❖** While we may celebrate the promise, we often bemoan the process
- **❖** Many of us quit because it's not easy
 - > Gotta get past the foolishness of our past
 - > Gotta deal with the reckoning of seeds sown
 - > Gotta persevere through what it will take to receive the blessing the right way

POINTS TO TAKE AWAY

(1) YOUR LIMP IS NOT AN INDICATION OF DEFEAT – BUT OF VICTORY

- O Let's you know that you have had an encounter with the Lord
- O Let's you know that you made it bruised, but you made it

(2) WHEN GOD TOUCHES YOU, YOU WILL NEVER WALK THE SAME!!

(2Co 5:17) Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

SONG: LAY YOUR HANDS ON ME JESUS

(3) JACOB LEARNED THAT THE WAY TO BLESSING IS CLINGING ON TO GOD – NOT THROUGH THE TRICKS OF THE FLESH

(Psa 118:8) It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man. (Psa 118:9) It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in princes.

- a. You can't manipulate God, you have to trust Him
- b. You can't lie to God
- c. You can't work your way to blessing
- d. You must depend upon His Grace

(Eph 2:8) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: (Eph 2:9) Not of works, lest any man should boast.

(4) INSTEAD OF COMPLAINING ABOUT YOUR LIMP, THANK GOD FOR HIS GRACE

(5) THOUGH IT MAY HAVE COST YOU, IT WAS WORTH IT

O Got a new name – no longer Trickster but Prince with God
