Significance of the Firstborn

- ❖ The firstborn had a special consecration to God Exodus 13:2
- Regarded as the representative of the father Gen. 49:3
- ❖ Head of the family upon father's death Gen. 27
- ❖ Receives a double portion of the father's inheritance Deut. 21:17
- ❖ Other scriptures to consider: Exo. 4:22-23; Rom. 8:29

The Providence of God and the Order of Sons

- ❖ In scripture, merely being born first did not always guarantee the full blessing
 - ➤ Ishmael and Isaac
 - Son of the flesh vs. the son of promise
 Gen. 16:1-6,15-16; 17:20-21; 18:9-14; 21:1-3
 - Esau and Jacob Gen. 27:19-41
 - Son of process vs son of purpose
- ❖ The prodigal son and the firstborn Luke 15:11-32
- ❖ David not first of Jesse's but still favored 1 Sam. 16:11; Psa. 89:27

Our Focus Passage Tonight: Genesis 48:1-22

Manasseh and Ephraim

NOTE

- ➤ They were adopted by their grandfather Jacob vs. 5
 - Equal by adoption
- > They were Joseph's sons born in Egypt
- > Both blessed but the second received the first blessing
- ❖ It was an intentional crossover
 - ➤ Physical sight was not the issue vs. 13
- ❖ Ephraim not first but chosen Jer. 31:9
