CHAPTER 3

What's Your Cause? (vs. 1)

- ❖ Note that Paul who is technically in Roman custody calls himself a prisoner of Jesus Christ
 - "In the day he was free to move around the house with the supervision of soldiers, but every night he was chained to a soldier to make sure he did not escape before his trial before Caesar." – David Guzik

Eph. 3:1, 4:1; Phil. 1:7, 13-16

- > No matter where we find ourselves, it should all be for Christ
- ➤ When we know the cause, it brings purpose and clarity 1 Sam. 17:28-30; Phil. 1:20-21

The Dispensation of Grace

- Dispensation: administration, stewardship
- ❖ Paul was given the stewardship of ministering to the Gentiles Act 9:15
- ❖ Vs. 3: God revealed unto Paul his assignment as his revealed what had been a mystery
 - Mystery: musterion: hidden purpose, counsel or will hidden from the ungodly and wicked but plain to the godly (Thayer's Dictionary)
 - Read 1 Cor. 2:14; Acts 22:17-21; Rom. 11:25; 16:25; Eph 3:4,9
 - Now the Gentiles would be included what is now known as the Christian Church, the Body of Christ Eph. 2:11-22
- ❖ Vs. 5: Revelation to the holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit Col. 1:26
 - This refers to NT apostles and prophets
- The Revelation: the inclusion of the Gentiles Gal. 3:28-29
 - Fellow heirs Rom. 8:16-17;
 - > Same body Rom. 8:17; Eph. 4:4, 16, 25
 - Partakers of His promise in Christ by the gospel Eph. 2:12-13

Called According to the Gift of Grace

- ❖ Vs. 7: Paul says was made a minister according to the gift of the grace of God − 1 Cor. 15:9-11 Rom. 15:14-16
 - ➤ God did a work in Paul in order to do a work through Paul Rom. 15:18 (MSG)

→ONE OF THE MOST TRAGIC MISTAKES YOU AND I CAN MAKE IS TO BELIEVE THAT WE ARE WHO WE ARE OUTSIDE OF THE GRACE OF GOD

Chapter 3 (continued)

- ❖ Vs. 8: Paul shows forth his understanding of the Grace of God on his life
 - ➤ Less than the least of all saints 1 Cor. 15:9
 - Paul's focus is summed up in this Col. 1:27-29
- ❖ Vs. 9: People can see Christ working in and through Paul
- Vs. 10: The angels learn of the manifold (many-sided) wisdom of God through 1 Pet. 1:12
 - ➤ Angels learn from us 1 Cor. 11:10; 1 Pet. 1:12; 1 Tim. 5:21
- Vs. 12: What we have as believers
 - ➤ Boldness Heb. 4:16
 - > Access with confidence Heb. 10:19-25
 - > Both by the faith of Him (faith in Him) John 14:6
- ❖ Vs. 13: Don't faint at my tribulations Phil. 1:14; 2 Cor. 1:6

- ❖ Vs. 14: For this cause
- ❖ Vs. 14: I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ
 - ➤ Paul's posture of humility while praying 1 Kings 8:54; Ezra 9:5; Psa. 95:6
 - ➤ We are to pray to the Father through the Son Mat. 6:6-9; John 16:23-24
- ❖ Vs. 16: He would grant you
 - > According to the riches of His glory Phil. 4:19
 - ➤ To be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man Col. 1:11-12; Rom. 7:22; 2 Cor. 4:16
- ❖ Vs. 17: That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith John 14:23; 1 John 4:7; Rev. 3:20
 - Are you rooted and grounded in love? Col. 1:23; Eph. 2:4; 1 Cor. 13:1-13
- ❖ Vs. 18: If you only knew: Eph. 1:18; Lam. 3:22-23
 - With all saints
 - > The breadth, length and depth and height Rom. 8:35-39
 - Width John 3:16
 - Length Jer. 31:3; Psa. 103:12
 - Depth Phil. 2:7-8
 - Height Eph. 2:6
- ❖ Vs. 19: And to know the love of Christ Psa. 86:5, 15;
 - ➤ How can you be filled with all the fullness without knowing Christ's Love? Eph. 1:23; 1 John 3:14; 1 John 4:7-20
- ❖ Vs. 20: The Doxology:
 - Now unto Him that is able Rom. 16:25; Isa. 59:1; Psalm 147:4-5; 1 Cor. 4:20; 2 Tim. 1:7
 - ➤ Able to do exceeding abundantly 1 Tim. 1:14; Isa. 55:7; John 10:10
 - According to the power Eph. 3:7; Eph. 1:19; Col. 1:29
 - ...power that worketh in us Rom. 8:5-14
- ❖ Vs. 21: Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout ages...Rom. 11:36
