Developing a Culture of Worship

- ❖ Whatever you place most before you is what eventually takes the deepest roots in you Deut. 6:5-10
- ❖ We must determine that we won't settle for anything less than genuine worship − 1 Kings 18:21; Joshua 24:15: Mat. 4:10

Wisdom is not optional but required

- ❖ If we are going to develop a culture of worship, it must include the areas addressed by this passage: Colossians 3:15-16
 - ➤ The peace (eirḗnē:peace, prosperity, quietness, rest) of God must rule (brabeúō: arbitrate, govern) our hearts John 14:27; Phil. 4:7
 - We are called to it in one body 1 Cor. 7:15; Eph. 4:4
 - \triangleright We are called to be thankful 1 Thes. 5:18
- ❖ We must allow the Word to not visit but dwell (enoikeō: to inhabit, influence for good) in us
 - ➤ In our hearts and minds Phil. 2:5
 - ➤ The work of the Word of God in obtaining wisdom Psa. 119:98; Psa. 19:7; 2 Tim. 3:15; Jer. 8:9
- Notice the correlation between wisdom, culture and worship
 - ➤ Vs. 16: Teaching and admonishing one another in:
 - Psalms and hymns and spiritual songs Eph. 5:19; Psa. 137:1-5
 - Singing with grace in our hearts to the Lord 1 Cor. 14:15; Col. 4:6
 - Let's compare Eph. 5:19 to Col. 3:16 filled with the Spirit and filled with the Word
 - \triangleright Vs. 17: do all in the name of the Lord Jesus 1 Cor. 10:31
 - If I can't do it in His Name, am I really worshipping Him in it? John 4:22
