What is Faith?

- ❖ Faith pistis: 1) conviction of the truth of anything, belief; in the NT of a conviction or belief respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, generally with the included idea of trust and holy fervour born of faith and joined with it; 2) fidelity, faithfulness, 2a) the character of one who can be relied on Thayer's Greek Definitions
- ❖ Faith: 1. complete trust or confidence in someone or something. 2. strong belief in God or in the doctrines of a religion, based on spiritual apprehension rather than proof. Oxford Languages Dictionary

What is faith to you?

Let's look at some principles on Faith

- We need a faith that is and not a faith that merely was (Now faith) John 3:16; Rom. 10:9; Heb. 11; Heb. 4:2
- Faith is real
 - ➤ Saving faith Eph. 2:8
 - Measure of faith Rom. 12:3; 2 Cor. 11:24-29; Heb 11 (by faith)
- ❖ Faith is the assurance, the confirmation, the proof
 - It enables my walk through the valleys of life Psa. 23:4; 2 Tim. 4:18
 - ➤ It allows me to draw closer to God in spite of me Heb. 10:22
 - ➤ It eliminates anxiety Phil 4:6-7; Pa. 73:26
 - It enables me to have peace with God Rom. 5:1
 - ➤ It provides me with eternal security John 10:28; Rom. 8:38-39
 - ➤ It enables me to be confident in God Heb. 10:35-37
- ❖ Faith ensures what we are hoping for Rom. 12:2; Jer. 29:11; 1 Pet. 1:3; Psa. 39:7; Heb. 6:18-20 (MSG)
- Faith validates the unseen
 - ➤ We walk by faith 2 Cor. 5:7
 - ➤ We speak by faith Pro. 18:21; Mark 11:23
 - ➤ We pray by faith Mat. 21:22
 - We obtain it by hearing, not seeing Rom. 10:17

Sustaining Faith

What does the word sustain mean?

- Sustain kûl A primitive root; properly to keep in; hence to measure; figuratively to maintain (in various senses): (be able to, can) abide, bear, comprehend, contain, feed, forbearing, guide, hold (-ing in), nourish (-er), be present, make provision, receive, sustain, provide sustenance (victuals). Strong's Hebrew and Greek Definitions
- ❖ Sustain: 1. strengthen or support physically or mentally. 2. undergo or suffer (something unpleasant, especially an injury).. − Oxford Languages Dictionary

Faith only sustains if I believe God to be my source

- ❖ Abraham knew this and operated as such –
- ❖ We must give it all to God Psa. 31 (also read MSG)
 - ➤ Surrendering by faith is not a sign of weakness but the ultimate sign of strength and dependence on the Will of God Mark 14:35-36
 - ➤ Sometimes we are just in God's way 2 Chr. 20:15-17
 - Stop meddling and start praying Mat. 5:38-48
 - Stop trying to get even and start blessing Pro. 25:21-23; 2 Kings 6:1-23

Fear causes us to look for a quick fix or way out instead of allowing God to sustain us in our "it"

- ❖ Let patience have its perfect work James 1:1-4 (MSG)
- ❖ Paul and Silas Acts 16:16-40 (vs. 37) Make sure you don't leave your witness and testimony as you leave the trial.
- Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego –
- ❖ Daniel did not allow the decree to change his devotion Dan. 6:10
- ❖ Job was willing to wait until his appointed time Job 14:14

We practice and grow our faith by maintaining instead of quitting

- Don't stop worshipping God you continue to worship Psa. 34:1; 1 Thes. 5:18; Heb. 13:15; Psa. 103
- ❖ Don't stop praying you add to your prayers 1 Thes. 5:17; Eph. 6:18; Col. 4:2
 - Add confessions Eph. 1:18; Rom. 8:26-27; Mat. 21:22; 1 John 5:14; Heb. 4:16; Psa. 121:1; Psa. 4:8
- ❖ Be fervent about your service and prayers Rom. 12:11; Eph. 1:16-18; James 5:16
- Don't cast away your confidence Heb. 10:35-39 (MSG)
- Don't stop serving Heb. 6:1-12 (MSG); 1 Cor. 15:57-58



We must teach our children how to endure

- ❖ The instruction was to train them up, not down Pro. 22:6; Psa. 127:3-5; Deut. 6:7-9
- ❖ Stop bailing them out and not holding them accountable − 1 Sam. 3:6-14; 1 Sam. 2:12-18
- ❖ Stop doing everything for them, depriving them of growth Pro. 18:9
- ❖ They just like us won't grow if we don't use what we know Heb. 5:13-14
- Learn to set memorials to remind them of the goodness of the Lord
 - Note Abraham's example Gen. 22:14

What is a mountain?

The Mustard Seed

- It's not the size of the seed but the potential of the seed
 - > It's ability to grow
 - > It doesn't require the best situation to grow in
 - Can grow in small, tight places
 - Can grow in difficult terrain
 - > It is not the smallest seed but the smallest of what is typically planted in the area

Releasing yourself to believe God

- ❖ I don't have to understand how and have the answer Pro. 3:5; 2 Cor. 3:4-5; Pro. 16:9
- Let go of the anxiety
- Realize that God is not limited Luke 1:37
- Letting go is not a sign of weakness but a sign of faith in God Gen. 22
 - You must understand that Isaac was Abraham's seed of promise Gen. 21:12
- ❖ We must learn to cast our cares upon Him 1 Pet. 5:6-7

Moving by faith requires work on our part

- Faith without works is dead James 2:14-26
- This work is often done away from the limelight Mat. 6:5-6;
- ❖ We have to trust God's process in spite of the circumstances Psa. 126:1-6

A faith that doesn't move you is a faith that won't move anything

- ❖ When we are moved, we are able to make faith moves Neh. 1:1-2:9
- You have to say something to the mountain Mat. 17:20
 - You have to speak with expectation Phil. 1:20
 - You have to speak acceptable words Psa. 19:13-14 (MSG)
 - ➤ Tell the mountain where to go Mat. 17:20; Mark 11:23 (cast into the sea)
- You have to move with expectation Mat. 17:21
 - This is not a one time move but a lifestyle move.
 - Note: The disciples didn't have time to pray and fast on the spot...



The Praise of Faith

We should always respond to our circumstances from a position of faith

- ❖ Faith that God can meet us in it Psa. 138:6-8
- Faith that God can bring us through it Psa. 46
- ❖ Faith that God is God in spite of it Psa. 90:1-2; Psa. 91

Faith is currency in the Kingdom of God

- ❖ Necessary to please Him Heb. 11:6
- ❖ Necessary when making requests of God James. 1:6-7

God enables us to overcome by sustaining, preserving, and empowering us

- Sustains us in His Word –
- Preserves us by His Power Psa. 37:28
 - ➤ Protects us Psa. 32:7
 - Shelters us Psa. 121:5
 - Keeps us Hos. 14 (key vs. 8)
 - Empowers us by enabling us Mat. 4:1; Luke 4:1

We must learn to appreciate the enabling Power of God

- Enabled with an answer Luke 12:8-12; Mat. 28:19-20; 1 Tim. 6:12; 1 Pet. 3:15
- Enabled to move and act Eph. 2:10; James 2:17-18
- Enabled to respond to God's goodness Psa. 103:1-5
 - Soul: nephesh: soul, self, life, creature, person, appetite, mind, living being, desire, emotion, passion (Brown-Driver-Briggs' Hebrew Definitions)

God never expects from you what He has not enabled you to give Him

- He has given you the ability to praise Him Psa. 150:6
 - From where you are Psa. 150:1
 - ➤ He has given you a readon Psa. 150:2
 - ➤ With what you have access to Psa. 150:3-5
 - ➤ With what you possess Psa. 150:6

It's up to you and I to exercise our faith by giving God the praise of Faith

- ❖ It confounds the enemy 2 Chr. 20:14-22
- ❖ It is a way we draw closer to God Psa. 22:3; Psa. 100-4-5; Heb. 13:15; 1 Pet. 2:9
- It draws the lost to Christ Acts 16:25-34
- ❖ It's in His Will for us 1 Thes. 5:18
